It has come to my attention that Mack Energy Corporation has petitioned for a hearing to be held before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on April 20, 1995, regarding the compulsory pooling of lands in the NW/4 of Section 27 T16S R38E \_\_\_\_\_

The purpose of this letter is to inform the Oil Conservation Division that Tierra Oil Company owns a small mineral interest in the subject lands. Furthermore, Tierra has received a written proposal from Mack Energy regarding the leasing of Tierra's interest in the subject lands. Mack Energy has Tierra's New Mexico mailing address as evidenced by the attached letter dated March 30, 1995, which Mack sent to Tierra.

Tierra should not be force pooled. Tierra would be willing to lease its interest or participate for its proportionate share of any well drilled on subject lands.
