



On July 6, 1995, the Commission issued Order #R-7285-A, Case #11317, which allowed for an unorthodox location and compulsory pooling in the:

Lea County, New Mexico

To be effective, it was required that said well must be commenced by October 1, 1995.


Bonneville Fuels Corporation, as operator, currently intends to drill said well, but it appears unlikely that it will be able to commence actual operations prior to October 1, 1995.
