NOW, on this 6th day of July, 1995, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Bahlburg Exploration Inc., seeks authorization to drill its Lowe Well No. 2 at an unorthodox oil well location 2540 feet from the South line and 100 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 25, Township 13 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, the NW/4 SW/4 of said Section 25 is to be dedicated to said well thereby forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit. Applicant further requests approval of the subject unorthodox location as to the King-Wolfcamp Pool, Undesignated King-Pennsylvanian Pool, and Undesignated King-Devonian Pool.
 - (3) Prior to the hearing, the applicant requested this matter be dismissed.
 - (4) Dismissal of this case should therefore be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Case No. 11318 is hereby dismissed.
