Dear Mr. Stogner:

Please let this letter serve as a supplement to Anadarko Petroleum Corporation's ("Anadarko") Motion for a Continuance.

First, as to the requested continuance, Anadarko, as stated in its Motion, needs additional time to prepare for the hearing. Also, on Friday, August 4, 1995 we received a Second Amended Application filed in this case by applicant. Because the application was amended, under Division rules the case must be continued for the next available Examiner Hearing, which is September 7, 1995.

Second, as to the request for an order staying injection operations, we believe this should be dismissed out-of-hand. Division Memorandum No. 3-85, cited by applicant, only applies to a stay pending a de novo hearing. That is not the present situation. Also, Nearburg has not submitted any proof that it is being harmed by injection; rather, it makes only unproven allegations. Furthermore, Yates has been injecting water into its well since 1988 or 1989, and Anadarko has been injecting water into its well since 1984. Since injection operations began, according to Nearburg's own application, approximately 8 million barrels of water have been injected into the Cisco/Canyon formation through the two wells. Continuing injection operations during the four week continuance requested by Anadarko will cause the injection of only a fraction of 1% of the water already injected. Thus, there is no immediate harm to applicant

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requiring a stay. Finally, upon information and belief, Nearburg drafted its application in November 1994, but did not file it until July 1995. If there was indeed immediate harm to applicant, it should have filed the application last fall rather than wait eight months to do so. Again, this shows the lack of immediate harm and a stay of injection is not necessary.
