APPLICATION OF EXXON CORPORATION
FOR A NON-STANDARD GAS PRORATION UNIT,

APPLICATION

Exxon Corporation hereby applies for a non-standard gas proration unit, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is the operator of the New Mexico "S" State Well No. 22, located 800 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, which is being recompleted as a gas well in the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool. The special rules and regulations for said pool require 160 acre gas well units, with a well to be located no nearer than 660 feet to the outer boundary of a proration unit.

2. Pursuant to Administrative Order NSP-1734(L), the above well has the S/2SW/4 of Section 2 dedicated to it. Said Order also approved the unorthodox location for the well.

3. Applicant seeks to modify Administrative Order NSP-1734(L) to provide for a non-standard gas spacing and proration unit for the subject well consisting of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2.

4. The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division grant the relief requested above.
