Dear Sir,

I am writing concerning the well 7-11 case no 11470, disposing of produced water being put back into the well. We have deeded land that is close to the well site. On our deeded and BLM leased lands there are several water wells, they range from 160 feet to 325 feet deep. The well site 7-11 is at higher elevation than our water wells.

Our concerns are that having the well site higher in elevation, is that cementing casing down 425 feet is close to where our well water is. Will this contaminate our water if a crack or hole develops in the casing? We have heard of underground streams flowing long distances. Would this affect that water?

If in the future we decide to develop our deeded land. We expect the water to be safe for all living things.

Our personal feelings are that we feel it should not be put back into a fresh water zone.

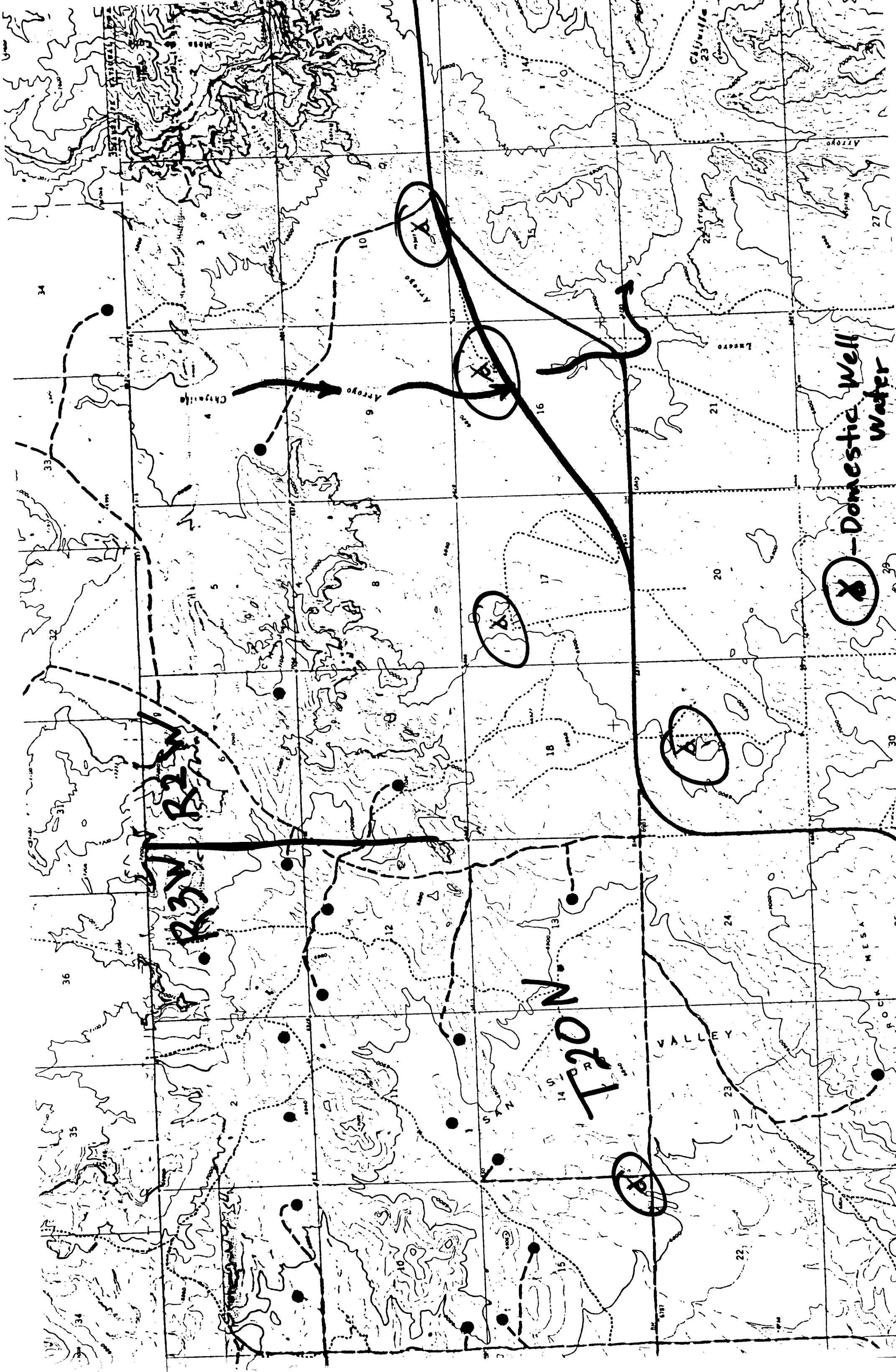
