19 following: I would like to at least temporarily continue

21 that I'm going to attempt to process this pooling case  
22 under the administrative rules.

23                 The reason I'm asking you to do so is that there  
24 is one interest owner in the 40-acre Devonian spacing unit,  
25 Ms. Johnston, that we simply cannot find, and I want to

1 make one last effort to find her and then, after doing so,  
2 ask to avoid the expense of a hearing and to process under  
3 the administrative pooling order, if I may do so.

4 And so what we're attempting to do is to  
5 eventually move this onto an administrative docket.

6 And subsequent to the hearing, then, I would  
7 submit this to you in writing and give you the necessary  
8 references so that you could see that we're in compliance  
9 with that process.

10 EXAMINER STOGNER: Case Number 11,544 will be  
11 continued to the July 11th, 1996, docket.


12 And it's also my understanding that you wish to
