The proposed allowables for the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool and  
the Tubb Oil and Gas Pool are less than the current allowables, as  
follows:

<u>Pool</u>	<u>Proposed Allowable</u>	<u>Current Allowable</u>
Blinebry	44,550	46,800
Tubb	16,750	18,425

Exxon requests that, at a minimum, the proposed allowables be  
increased to those set for the April-September 1996 period.

In addition, Exxon may present evidence on increasing the  
allowables in the Blinebry, Tubb, and Eumont pools.
