#### Ladies and Gentlemen:

Attached please find a letter which was forwarded to Texaco Exploration & Production Inc. on November 19, 1996. In said letter, Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company ("BR") expressed its concerns about the greater risk and expense associated with drilling the multi-lateral horizontal well which was proposed by Texaco. As an alternative, BR proposed the drilling of the Dublin "23" Federal No. 1 as a less expensive vertical well which would realize greater economic return for all participants.

Attached for your review and execution, please find an AFE in the amount of \$234,735 to drill, complete and equip the Rhodes "23" Fed Com No. 1, formerly proposed to Texaco as the Dublin "23" Federal No. 1. Should you agree to participate in the drilling of same, please execute the AFE and return to the undersigned by December 17th. A Communitization Agreement and Joint Operating Agreement will be forwarded you at a later date for your review and execution.

As Texaco is scheduled for hearing on December 5, 1996 for compulsory pooling of their horizontal Rhodes "23" Fed. Com No. 1, BR has also applied for compulsory pooling of its vertical Rhodes "23" Fed Com No. 1. BR's hearing should appear on the December 19, 1996 docket.
