MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name is William F. Carr with the Santa Fe law firm Campbell, Carr, Berge and Sheridan. We represent Nearburg Exploration Company in this matter.

As the Examiner will recall, this case came before you and was heard on April the 1st, 1999. In this case, Nearburg is seeking the creation of a new Strawn Pool and the adoption of temporary -- or special pool rules, including provisions for 80-acre spacing and proration units.

On the date of the hearing we learned that this portion of the Strawn interval was included within the vertical limits of the Anderson Ranch-Pennsylvanian Pool, and at the hearing you advised Nearburg that the Oil Conservation Division was in the process of contracting the Anderson Ranch-Penn Pool's vertical limits to exclude the Strawn in this area.

Nearburg was directed to meet with Mr. Paul Kautz

in the Hobbs District Office to discuss this matter, and that has been done.

The contraction of the Anderson Ranch-Penn Pool will be docketed as Case 12,184. It is Paragraph F in that particular docket, and the case is scheduled for hearing on May the 13th.

When the pool is contracted, the Nearburg

been provided will be proper. And so we would request the

case be taken under advisement based on the April 1, 1999,

record, and that an order entered in this matter, following

the entry of an order by the Division in Case 12,184.
