ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This case came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on December 16, 1999, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner David R. Catanach.

NOW, on this 10th day of January, 2000, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice has been given as required by law, and the Division has jurisdiction of this case and its subject matter.

(2) Yates Petroleum Corporation, the applicant in this case, appeared at the hearing on December 16, 1999 and presented evidence in support of its application. With no additional appearances, the case was taken under advisement.

(3) Subsequent to the hearing, it was determined that by Order No. R 8170-E-1 dated October 28, 1991, the Division terminated the Special Rules and Regulations for the Burton Flat-Morrow Gas Pool.

(4) By letter dated January 3, 2000, the applicant, Yates Petroleum Corporation, requested that this case be dismissed.

(5) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) At the request of the applicant, Yates Petroleum Corporation, Case No. 12310 is hereby dismissed.
