Re: Division Administrative Order NSL-4498/Division Case No. 12462.

Dear Messrs. Kellahin and Carr:

Per Mr. Carr's letter dated August 15, 2000, Division Administrative Order NSL-4498, which order approved an unorthodox gas well location within the W/2 of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, being a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit within the Undesignated Wilson-Morrow Gas Pool, for Santa Fe Snyder Corporation's Outland State Unit Well No. 1-Y (**API No. 30-025-34818**) located 638 feet from the South line (which is only 22 feet from a standard location) and 739 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 12, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, New Mexico, shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.

It is my understanding that Division Case No. 12462, which is an application for the same thing, will be heard on September 7, 2000. It would appear that a location that is only 22 feet unorthodox could warrant a full hearing (I could be wrong) before a Division Hearing Examiner whose schedules and dockets are already congested, I therefore strongly urge both parties to seek an equitable solution on their own in this matter.
