While entering data into the Division's automation system concerning my hearing on March 8, 2001, I discovered the advertisement in this case contained an insufficient legal description of the well, dedicated acreage, and proposed provocative intervals. I have therefore prepared the following which will be placed on the April 5, 2001 hearing docket:

"CASE 12608: (REOPENED AND READVERTISED)

Application of David H. Arrington Oil & Gas, Inc. for an unorthodox gas well location, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks approval to deepen its existing Mayfly "14" State Well No. 4 (API No. 30-025-34865), located at an unorthodox gas well location 1650 feet from the North line and 371 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 14, Township 16 South, Range 35 East, NMPM Lea County, New Mexico, from its current depth of 11,550 feet to an approximate depth of 12,100 feet in order to test both the Townsend-Morrow Gas Pool and deeper Undesignated Townsend-Mississippian Gas Pool within a standard 320-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit comprising the W/2 of section 14. This well is located approximately five miles west of Lovington, New Mexico".
