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STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Application of EOG Resources, Inc. for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface through the top 100 feet of the Mississippian Chester formation underlying the W/2 of Section 7, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M. for any formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing which includes but is not necessarily limited to the South Bell Lake-Morrow Gas Pool.

Applicant proposes to dedicate these pooled units to its Bell Lake Unit Well No. 8 to be drilled at a standard location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit E) of said Section 7. Also to be considered will the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 22 miles northwest of Jal, New Mexico.


