

Gentlemen:

I represent Redrock Operating Ltd. Co. ("Redrock") in this matter. On June 28, 2001, at the Examiner's hearing of the referenced case, Mr. Stogner ordered Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. ("Nearburg") to immediately shut-in its Grama Ridge "34" State Well No. 1 located in Unit H of Section 34, T21S, R34E. This well is capable of commercial production from the Morrow formation of the Grama Ridge Morrow Gas Pool. The parties are awaiting an order of the Division in this case.

The purpose of my letter is to clarify the "shut-in" order while we are waiting the entry of the order. I would like to know the Division's position should Nearburg abandon the commercial production in the Morrow and attempt to recomplete the well for production from the Bone Springs or another shallower gas formation spaced on 160 acres.
