

Amended application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for amendment of compulsory pooling order No. R-11542 to change the dedicated spacing unit, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order amending pooling order No. R-11542 to pool all mineral interests in all formations from the surface to the base of the Mississippian formation in W/2 of Section 13, Township 15 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to form a standard spacing and proration unit for all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent which includes but is not necessarily limited to the undesignated Morton-Morrow Gas Pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to the Chevy AWV State Com Well No. 1 to be drilled at a standard location 1650 feet from the South and West lines of said Section 13 to a depth sufficient to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Mississippian formation. Said well is located approximately 6 miles northwest of Lovington, New Mexico.
