OIL & GAS LEASE

THIS AGREEMENT made this 14th day of August, 2001 between Terry Delonas, dealing in his sole and separate property, c/o 3613 Mirror Court, Spring, Texas, 77388, herein catled Lessor (whether one of more) and PERMIAN RESOURCES HOLDINGS, INC., P.O. Box 580, Midland, TX 79702, Lessee:

1. Lessor, in consideration of TEN AND OTHER DOLLARS in hand paid, receipt of which is here acknowledged, and of the royaltles herein provided and of the agreements of the Lessee harein contained, hereby grants, lesses and lets exclusively unto Lessee for the purpose of investigating, exploring, prospecting, drilling, and operating for and producing oil and gas, injecting gas, waters, other fluids, and other structures and things thereon to produce, save, take care of, treat, process, store and transport said minerals, the following described land in Les County, New Mexico, to wit:

S/2SE/4 Section 7, T-16-S, R-36-E, NMPM

Said land is estimated to comprise 80.0 acres, whether it actually comprises more or less.

- 2. Subject to the other provisions herein contained, this lease shall remain in force for a term of Three years from this date (called "primary term") and as long thereafter as oil or gas is produced from said land or from land with which said land is pooled.
- 3. The royalties to be paid by Lessee are: (a) on all, and other liquid hydrocarbons saved at the well. Three-shdeenths of that produced and saved from said land, same to be delivered at the wells or to the credit of Lesser in the pipelline to which the wells may be connected; (b) on gas, including casing head gas or other gasoous substance produced from said land and used off the premises or used in the manufacture of gasoline or other products, the market value at the well of Three-shdeenths of the gas used, provided that on gas sold on or off the premises, the royalties shall be Three-sixteenths of the amount realized from such sale; (c) and at any time when this lease is not validated by other provisions hereof and there is a gas and/or condensate well on said land, or land pooled therewith, but gas or condensate is not being so said or used and such well is shut in, either before of the production therefrom, then on or before 90 days after said well is shut in, and thereafter at annual Intervals, Lessee may pay or tender an advance shut-lin royalty equal to \$1.00 per not acre of Lessor's gas acreage then held under this lesse by the party making such payment or tender, and so long as said shut-in royalty is paid or tondered this lesse shall not terminate and it shell be considered under all clauses hereof that gas is being produced from the leased pramises in paying quantities. Each such payment shall be paid on tendered to repair paying the bat the time of such payment would be entitled to receive the royalties which would be paid under this lesse if the well-wore in fact producing. The payment or tender of shut-in royalties and shut-in royalties may be made by check or draft. Any timely payment or tender of shut-in royalty which is made in a bone fide ettempt to make proper payment, but which is erroneous in whole or in part as to parties or emounts, shall nevertheless be sufficient to prevent termination of this lesse in the same manner as though a proper payment logather with such written instruments (
- 4. This is a paid-up lease and Lessee shall not be obligated during the primary term hereof to commence or continue any operations of whatsoever character or to make any payments hereunder in order to maintain this lease in force during the primary term; however, this provision is not intended to relieve Lessee of the obligation to pay royalties on actual production pursuant to the provision or Paragraph 3 hereof.
- 5. Lesses is hereby granted the right and power, from time to time, to pool or combine this lease, the land covered by it or any part or horizon thereof with any other land, leases, mineral estates or parts thereof for the production of oil or gas. Units pooled hereunder shall not exceed the standard proration unit fixed by law or by the Oil Conservation Division of the Energy and Minerals Department of the State of New Mexico or by any other lawful authority for the pool or area in which said land is situated, plus a tolerance of ten percent. Lesses shall file whiten unit designations in the County in which the premises are located and such units may be designated from time to time and elther before or after the completion of wells. Drilling operations on or production from any part of any such unit shall be considered for all purposes, except the payment of royalty, as operations conducted upon or production from the land described in this lease. There shall be allocated to the tand covered by this lease included in any such unit that portion of the total production of pooled minerals from wells in the unit, after deducting any used in lease or unit operations, which the net oil or gas acresgagin the land covered by this lease included in the unit. The production so allocated shall be considered for all purposes, including the payment or delivery of mystly, to be the entire production of pooled minerals from the portion of said land covered hereby and included in said unit in the same manner as though produced from said land under the terms of this lease. Any pooled unit designated by Lessee, as provided herein, may be dissolved by Lessee by recording an appropriate instrument in the County where the land is situated at any time after the completion of a dry hole or the cessallon of production on said unit.
- 6. If at the expiration of the primary term there is no well upon said land capable of producing oil or gas, but Lessee has commenced operations for drilling or reworking thereon, this lesse shall remain in force so long as operations are proseculed with no cessation of more than 60 consecutive days, whether such operations be on the same well or on a different or additional well or wells, and if they result in the production of oil or gas, so long thereafter as oil or gas is produced from said land. If, after the expiration of the primary term, all wells upon said land should become incapable of producing for any cause, this lesse shall not terminate if Lessee commences operations for additional drilling or reworking within 60 days. Thereafter. If any drilling, additional drilling, or reworking operations hereunder result in production, then this lesse shall remain in full force so long thereafter as oil or gas is produced hereunder.
- 7. Lessee shall have free use of oil, gas and water from said land, except water from Lessor's wells and tanks, for all operations hereunder, and the royalty shall be computed after deducting any so used. Lessee shall have the right at any time during or after the expiration of this lesse to remove all property and futures placed by Lessee on said land, including the right to draw end remove all casing. When required by Lessor, Lessee will bury all pipe lines on cultivated tands below ordinary plow depth, and no well shall be drilled within two hundred feet (200 ft.) of any residence or barn now on said land without Lessor's consent. Lessor shall have the privilege, at his risk and expense, of using gas from any gas well on said land for stoves and inside lights in the principal dwelling thereon, out of any surplus gas not needed for operations hereunder.
- 8. The rights of either party hereunder may be assigned in whole or in part and the provisions hereof shall extend to their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns; but no change in the ownership of the land or in the ownership of, or rights to receive, royalties or shut in royalties, however accomplished shall operate to enlarge the obligations or diminish the rights of Lessee; and no such change or division shall be binding upon Lessee for any purpose until 30 days after Lessee has been furnished by certified mail at Lessee at principal place of business with acceptable instruments or certified copies thereof constituting the chain of title from the original Lessor. If any such change in ownership occurs through death of the owner, Lessee may, at its option, pay or tender any royalties or shut-in royalties in the name of the decessed or to his estate or to his heirs, executor or administrator until such time as Lessee has been furnished with evidence satisfactory to Lessee as to the persons entitled to such sums. An assignment of this lease in whole or in part shall, to the extent of such assignment, relieve and discharge Lessee of any obligations hereunder and, if Lessee or assignee of part or parts hereof shall fail or make default in the payment of the proportionate part of royalty or shut-in royalty due from such Lessee or assignee or fall to comply with any of the provisions of this lease, such default shall not affect this lease insofar as it covers a part of said lands upon which Lessee or any assignee thereof shall properly comply or make such payments.
- 9. Should Lessee be prevented from complying with any express or implied covenant of this lease, or from conducting drilling or reworking operations hereunder, or from producing oil or gas hereunder by reason of scarcity or inability to obtain or use equipment or material, or by operation of force majoure, or by Federal or state law or any order, rule or regulation of governmental authority, then while so prevented, Lessee's duty shall be suspended, and Lessee duly shall not be liable for failure to comply therewith; and this lease shall be extended while and so long as Leasee is prevented by any such cause from conducting drilling or reworking operations or from producing oil or gas hereunder; and the time while Lessee is so prevented shall not be counted against Lessee, anything in this lease to the contrary notwithstanding.
- 10. Lessor hereby warrants and agrees to defend the title to said land and agrees that Lessee at its option may discharge any tax, mortgage or other lien upon said land, and in the event Lessee does so it shall be subrogated to such lien with the right to enforce same and to apply royalties and shut-in royalties payable hereunder toward satisfying same. Without impairment of Lessee's rights under the warranty, if this lease covers a less interest in the oil or gas in all or any part of said land than the entire and undivided fee simple estate (whether Lessor's interest is herein specified or not) then the royaltles, shut-in royalty, and other payments, if any, accruing from any part as to which this lease covers less than such full interest, shall be paid only in the proportion which the interest therein, if any, covered by this lease, bears to the whole and undivided fee simple estate therein. Should any one or more of the parties named above as Lessors fall to execute this lease, it shall nevertheless be binding upon the party or parties executing the same.
- 11. Lessee, its or his successors, heirs and assigns, shall have the right at any time to surrender this lesse, in whole or in part, to Lessor or his heirs, auccessors and assigns by delivering or mailing a release thereof to the Lessor, or by placing a release thereof of record in the County in which said land is situated; thereupon Lessee shall be relieved from all obligations, expressed or implied of this agreement as to screage so surrendered, and thereafter the shut-in royalty payable increunder shall be reduced in the proportion that the acreage covered hereby is reduced by said release or releases.
