APPLICATION

ARCO (BP), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an order authorizing the simultaneous dedication of the following wells to an existing 233.79-acre spacing unit comprised of Lots 1 through 5 (SE/4 SW/4 and S/2 SE/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 31, Township 20.5 South, Range 22 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico in the Undesignated Little Box Canyon-Morrow Gas Pool:

- A. Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No. 2 located at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the North and West lines of said irregular Section 31, and
- B. Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No. 5 to be drilled at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 1800 feet from the West line of said irregular Section 31.

In support of its application, ARCO (BP) states:

- 1. The Morrow formation in the Little Box Canyon-Morrow Gas Pool consists of multiple pay intervals (the lower A zone and the upper B zone) which are separate from and not in communication with other pay intervals in the Morrow formation.

2. ARCO (BP) is the operator of a 233.79-acre spacing and proration comprised of irregular Section 31, Township 20.5 South, Range 22 East, NMPM, Eddy County New Mexico. This spacing unit is currently dedicated in the Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No.2 which produces from the Morrow B zone. The Morrow A zone is not present in the Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No. 2 and to be able to produce the reserves in this Morrow sand an additional well is needed.

3. This pool is governed by the acreage and well location requirements of Division Rule 104.C.(2) of the General Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Division which provide in part:

- (A) the initial well on a 320-acre unit shall be located no closer than 660 feet to the outer boundary of the quarter section on which the well is located and no closer than 10 feet to any quarter-quarter section line or subdivision inner boundary; and
- (B) only one infill well on a 320-acre unit shall be allowed provided that the well is located in the quarter section on the 320-acre unit not containing the initial well and is no closer than 660 feet to the outer boundary of the quarter section and no closer than 10 feet to any quarter-quarter section line or subdivision inner boundary.

4. ARCO (BP) seeks an exception to Rule 104.C.(2)(b) to permit it to drill the Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No. 5 to the Morrow A Zone of the Undesignated Little Box Canyon-Morrow Gas Pool. This location will be in the same quarter section containing the initial Morrow well on this spacing unit. ARCO (BP) seeks permission

for only two wells on this irregular 233.79-acre unit but desires to locate the infill well in the same quarter section equivalent as the initial well.

5. Approval of the drilling of the Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No. 5 and the simultaneous dedication of the Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well Nos. 2 and 5 to the 233.79-acre Morrow spacing unit comprised of irregular Section 31 will protect correlative rights by affording ARCO (BP) the opportunity to produce the reserves in the separate and distinct Morrow pay zones under this spacing unit which cannot currently be produced by the Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No. 2.


6. The names and addresses of the persons to whom notice of this application will be provided in accordance with Oil Conservation Division Rules and Regulations is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

7. Approval of this application will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, ARCO (BP) requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on January 10, 2002 and after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order granting an exception to Division Rule 104.C.(2)(b) and approving the simultaneous dedication of the existing 233.79-acre spacing unit comprised of irregular Section 31 to the ARCO (BP) Sweet thing Federal Unit Well No. 5 to be dilled to test the A Zone of the Morrow formation at a location 660 feet from the North line and 1800 feet from the West line of Section 35; and the ARCO (BP) Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No 2 located at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the North and West lines which produces from the Upper B Zone of the Morrow formation

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an exception to Division Rule 104.C.(2)(b) to permit the simultaneous dedication of the following wells to an existing 233.79-acre spacing and proration unit in the Morrow formation, Undesignated Little Box Canyon-Morrow Gas Pool, comprised of irregular Section 31, Township 20.5 South, Range 22 East, NMPM:

- A. the Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No. 5 to be drilled to test the Morrow A Zone at a location 660 feet from the North line and 1800 feet from the West line; and
- B. the Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No. 2 which produces from the Morrow B Zone located at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the North and West lines.


Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that ARCO (BP) has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an exception to Rule 104.C.(2)(b) to permit the simultaneous dedication of the following wells to an existing 233.79-acre spacing and proration unit in the Morrow formation comprised of irregular Section 31, Township 20.5 South, Range 22 East, NMPM: the Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No. 5 to be drilled to test the Morrow A Zone at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 1800 Feet from the West line; and the Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No. 2 which produces from the Morrow B Zone located at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the North and West lines of said irregular Section 31 in the Undesignated Little Box Canyon-Morrow Gas Pool.

This application has been set for hearing before a Division Examiner on January 10, 2002. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases are required by Division Rule 1208.B to file a Prehearing Statement three days in advance of a scheduled hearing. This statement must include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses the party will call to testify at the hearing; the approximate time the party will need to present its case; and identification of any procedural matters that are to be resolved prior to the hearing.
