Culwin Queen Unit 4&5 - These wells produce.

1992 1980 1991 1993
Culwin Queen Unit 2, 6, 16 & 17. We are currently replacing flow and power lines within the unit and reworking several wells. These specific wells will be worked on or about every two months, having them all producing within eight months.

1997 Featherstone State - We do not own this well it was sold to Marathon in 1997.

1997 Gulf A State #1 - A C-108 is being prepared to convert to water disposal.

1997 Forehand #1 - This well produces and always has.

1997 Forehand #3 - This is an approved water disposal well.

Hinkle B Federal #8 & 20 - These wells are producing

1997 Huron Federal #1 - Sundry Notice has been approved by the BLM for plugging, and will proceed as soon as a plugging company is available.

1996 Lakey Com #1 - A C-103 will be filed for Plug and abandonment and will be carried out as soon as a plugging company is available.

1996 Lusk B #1 - A C-103 will be filed for Plug and abandonment and will be carried out as soon as a plugging company is available.

1996 Myrtle Myra #3 - A C-108 is being prepared to convert to water disposal.

1996 State #6 - Will rework within 90 days and place back on production.

1988 State G Com #1 - Proposal to partners to recomplete into the Cisco formation, operations should start with six months.

Texas Crude #1, 2 - With the BLM's knowledge we are laying flow lines for water disposal and installing new tank batteries for these wells and will place on production when surface work is completed.
