## TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. MACEY: The next case is 905. Mr. Porter, do you have a statement you want to make in connection with this matter?

MR. PORTER: I believe copies of the proposed Form C-110 were circulated at the last hearing. I think the reason for the proposed changes are obvious. I might review them.

In the first place this form has a space for the showing of both the casinghead gas transporter and the oil transporter which would eliminate the necessity of having to file two separate forms. Then you will notice in the body of the form there is a space to explain the disposition of casinghead gas if a connection is not available at the time that the well is completed. I believe it would necessitate the changing of only one word in Rule 1109, and that is as to the number of copies to be filed. The new form would require five copies so that one copy could be sent to the authorized transporter of casinghead gas.

MR. MACEY: Anyone have any questions they would like to

ask of Mr. Porter? We will introduce your letter and proposed form

in the record.

Anyone have a statement in the case? If not we will take the case under advisement and take a short recess.
