ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on May 18, 1955, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 13th day of Jume, 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as prescribed by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That pool creations and extensions as advertised, and as supported by proper testimony and recommendations presented in the subject hearing, should be approved in accordance with the Commission's motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission upon its own motion be, and the same hereby is approved as follows:

(a) That a new pool be created in Chaves County, New Mexico, designated as the Apache Spring-Wolfcamp Pool, classified as an oil pool for production from the Welfcamp formation, and described as follows:

TOWNSHIP II SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, NMPM E/2 Section 12

TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, NMPM W/2 Section 7

(Discovery well: The Atlantic Refining Company's Federal Union Well No. 1, NW/4 SW/4 7-115-31E, completed March 25, 1955, with top of perforations at 7929 feet.)

(b) That the High Lonesome Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as previously classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, NMPM NW/4 Section 16

(c) That the Anderson Ranch-Devonian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as previously classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM Lots 13, 14, 15 and 16 of Section 2

(d) That the Crossroads Poel in Lea County, New Mexico, as previously classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM E/2 Section 26

(e) That the Denton Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as previously classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM E/2 Section 25

(f) That the Denten-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as previously classified, defined and described should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM NW/4 Section 25

(g) That the Mescalero-Devonian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as previously classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM SE/4 Section 27

(h) That the Vacuum Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as previously classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM SE/4 Section 36

(i) That the Blinebry Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as previously classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM SW/4 Section 25; E/2 Section 26
