ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on October 17, 1957, November 14, 1957, and again on July 16, 1958, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this $\int_{0}^{\frac{t}{2}} day$ of August, 1958, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the preponderance of the evidence presented in this case indicates that one well will efficiently and economically drain 320 acres in the Bagley-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) That the Special Rules and Regulations for the Bagley-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool as set forth in Order No. R-1091 should be continued in effect until further order of the Commission.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the Special Rules and Regulations for the Bagley-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, as set forth in Order No. R-1091, be and the same are hereby continued in effect until further order of the Commission.

(2) That this order shall become effective September 1, 1958.
