said case and being fully advised in the premises;


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


SECTION 1. That the Stanolind Oil and Gas Company is hereby granted
an unorthodox spacing for the following well:

Stanolind Oil and Gas Company - W. S. Capps No. 10X in the NESE
Section 3, Township 19S, Range 38E, Hobbs Field -- with the following
footage location: 1980 feet North of the South line and 1293 feet West
of the East line of ~~(said NESE)~~ of said section.
