ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at ten o'clock A.M., May 14, 1945, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 14th day of May, 1945, the Commission having before it for consideration the testimony adduced at the hearing of said case and being fully advised in the premises;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the order herein shall be known as the:

"ALSTON UNIT AGREEMENT ORDER"

SECTION 1. (a) That the project herein shall be known as the Alston Unit Agreement and shall hereinafter be referred to as the Project.

(b) That the plan by which the Project shall be operated shall be embraced in the form of agreement designated as the "Alston Unit Agreement, Roosevelt County, New Mexico", dated "the ____ day of January, 1945", a copy of which is annexed to the applicant's application as "Exhibit A".

SECTION 2. That the Alston Unit Agreement shall be and is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. (a) That the Unit Area shall be:

In Township 7 South, Range 35 East
All of Sections 7, 8, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21,
22, 27, 28, 29 and 30
Section 9 - S/2
Section 15 - S/2 N/2 and S/2

Embracing 9069.52 acres.

(b) The Unit Area may be enlarged or diminished as provided in said plan.


SECTION 4. That any party owning rights in the unitized substances who does not commit such rights to said Unit Agreement before the effective date thereof may thereafter become parties thereto by subscribing to such Agreement or a counterpart thereof. The Unit Operator shall file with the Commission within 15 days an original of any such counterpart.

SECTION 5. That the order herein shall terminate ipso facto on the termination of said Unit Agreement.

SECTION 6. That the order herein shall become effective upon its execution.
