AN ORDER APPROVING AN UNORTHODOX LOCATION  
FOR WELL NO. 25 IN THE SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SECTION 23  
TOWNSHIP 21 S. R. 34 E. (2320', of the north  
line and 2880' west of the east line of said  
section) N.M.P.M. IN THE WEST EUNICE POOL,  
LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 10:00 o'clock a.m., July 15, 1948 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW:

On this 15th day of July 1948 the Commission having before it for consideration testimony adduced at the hearing of said cause and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

1. That due public notice having been given in compliance with law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case.
2. That two strings of tools were lost in the original orthodox location for well no 25, in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  section 23, in township 21, S. R., 34 E, necessitating abandonment, and skidding to the unorthodox location described as 2320' south of the north line and 2880' west of the east line of said section.
3. That applicant is the holder of all offset acreage.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the application of Wilson Oil Company, for an order approving unorthodox well location 2320' south of the north line and 2880' west of the east line of section 23, township 21 S. R., 34 E, N.M.P.M. in the west Eunice pool, Lea County, New Mexico be, and the same hereby is approved, and,
2. That the O - 101, heretofore issued for the original location stand corrected in conformance herewith.
3. That should production be had, such well shall never be produced, by itself, or in conjunction with other wells on the same 40 acre unit in excess of the allowable prescribed for the west Eunice pool.
