NORTH LINE AND 1370 FEET EAST OF THE WEST
LINE, SECTION 7, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,
RANGE 30 EAST, N.M.P.M., IN THE LOCO
HILLS POOL, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 10:00 o'clock A.M., March 31, 1949, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 19th day of April, 1949, the Commission having before it for consideration the testimony adduced at the hearing of said cause and being fully advised in these premises:

FINDS:


1. That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case.
2. That the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 30 East, is Federal acreage and the Federal Oil and Gas Supervisor has approved the application filed herein for an unorthodox well location.
3. That a regular and orthodox location on this acreage would be uneconomic for the reason that the evidence shows that the oil-water contact of the pool indicated on the map introduced as "Exhibit B", filed in the cause, might interfere with or prevent production.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of Franklin, Aston and Fair for an order is hereby approved for an unorthodox well location 1270 feet south of the north line and 1370 feet east of the west line of Section 7 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$) Township 18 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M., in the Loco Hills Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that should production be had at the location aforesaid, the well by itself or in conjunction with other wells on the same 40 acre tract shall not be produced in excess of the allowable now fixed or which may hereafter be fixed by the Commission for the Loco Hills Pool.
