IN THE MATTER OF THE TWIN OIL CORPORATION  
FOR AN ORDER UNITIZING THE NORTHEAST QUARTER  
OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) OF SECTION  
4, TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, N.M.P.M.,  
LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE,  
AUTHORIZING THE DRILLING OF A WELL OR WELLS  
UPON THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED LAND: BEGINNING  
AT A POINT 660 FEET WEST OF THE SOUTHEAST  
CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTH-  
EAST QUARTER (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) OF SAID SECTION, THENCE  
ON A DIRECT LINE NORTH 420 FEET, THENCE ON A  
DIRECT LINE WEST 210 FEET, THENCE ON A DIRECT  
LINE SOUTH 420 FEET, THENCE ON A DIRECT LINE  
EAST 210 FEET, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 2  
ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS, AND FIXING AN  
ALLOWABLE THEREFOR.


ORDER OF THE COMMISSION
