

All named parties in the following cases, and notice to the public:

Case 190

In the matter of the application of Twin Oil Corporation for an order unitising the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, N. M. P. M. or in the alternative, authorizing the drilling of a well or wells upon the following described lands:

Beginning at a point 660 feet west of the southeast corner of, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, N. M. P. M., thence on a direct line north 420 feet, thence on a direct line west, 210 feet, thence on a direct line south 420 feet, thence on a direct line east 210 feet, containing approximately 2 acres of land more or less, and fixing an allowable therefor.


