Reference is made to the application of Rufus G. Clay for an order granting permission to dually complete Etz Well No. 1 in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 27, T. 23 S., R. 36 E., N.M.P.M. in the Cooper-Jal pool, Lea County, New Mexico. Public hearing on this application is scheduled to be heard under Case 196 on September 20, 1949.

I wish to acknowledge receipt and thank you for your letter of September 12 furnishing me with a copy of the application of Rufus G. Clay. It appears that the proposal provides for a dual completion to separate by formation packer, gas well gas from the Yates formation and oil production from the Seven Rivers formation. This office is interested in the proposed work as the well is an east and north offset to Federal leases.

The proposed dual completion is similar to several such completions recently made in sec. 36, T. 23 S., R. 36 E. under the authority of Commission Orders 750, 801, 810 and 829 in the Langlie-Mattix pool.

This is to advise that this office offers no objection to dual completion of Etz Well No. 1 as requested by Mr. Clay providing requirements are made for adequate testing to assure prevention of commingling of gas and fluid hydrocarbons from the two different producing reservoirs.
