O R D E R

This matter came on for hearing at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on December 22, 1950, and the Commission being duly advised,

FINDS:

1. That it has jurisdiction of this matter and of the parties interested therein, due notice having been given.
2. That it is in the best interest of conservation and good administration that Rule 503-a of this Commission be amended so as to change the dates for the monthly State-wide hearings on allowable production.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That Rule 503-a adopted by Order No. 850 be amended to read as follows:

"The Commission shall meet between the 10th and 25th of each month for the purpose of setting the allowable production of oil and gas for the State for the following proration period."
