APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF UNORTHODOX DRILLING LOCATION

To: The New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission,
Santa Fe, New Mexico.

1. Byrd-Frost, Inc., hereby makes application for approval of an unorthodox Picture Cliffs drilling location for the L. B. Lodewick No. 2 well to be drilled on lands covered by Federal Oil and Gas Lease Santa Fe 077974, the drilling location to be 895 feet East of the West line and 895 feet North of the South line of Section Eighteen (18), Township Twenty-seven (27) North, Range Nine (9) West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

2. The necessity for the unorthodox location is based on topographical conditions which are such as to make an orthodox location, under Rule 104 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, almost prohibitive and the drilling of an orthodox location would be unduly burdensome.

3. It is respectfully requested that the hearing on this application before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission be set at the earliest possible date.
