

IN THE MATTER OF THE HEARING CALLED BY THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF NEW MEXICO FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSIDERING:

THE APPLICATION OF GULF OIL CORPORATION FOR AUTHORITY TO USE FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL PURPOSES BETWEEN 4200 AND 4600 FEET, AFTER DEEPENING, ITS EUNICE KING WELL NO. 2, NW/4 NW/4 SEC. 28, TWP. 21 S., RGE. 37 E., NMPM, PENROSE-SKELLY POOL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

## ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

## BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 10 a. m. on October 23, 1951, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

- NOW, on this 19 day of November, 1951, the Commission, a quorum being present, having fully considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,
- FINDS: (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause, the subject matter thereof, and the persons interested therein.
- (2) That it would be in the interests of conservation and the protection of correlative rights, and would prevent injury to neighboring leases or properties to permit applicant to use for salt water disposal purposes its Eunice King Well No. 2, located in the NW/4 NW/4 Section 28, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, in the Penrose-Skelly pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That the Gulf Oil Corporation be, and said corporation hereby is given authority to use its Eunice King Well No. 2, NW/4 NW/4 Section 28, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, for salt water disposal purposes, in the open-hole section between 4200 and 4600 feet in the San Andres formation.
- (2) That the effectiveness of this order is conditioned upon the compliance of applicant with the following requirements:
- (a) That said Eunice King Well No. 2 be deepened to an approximate depth of 4600 feet.
- (b) That a 5-1/2" liner be set at approximately 4200 feet, leaving an open-hole section only in the San Andres formation.

Otherwise this order to be of no force or effect whatever.

Nothing in this order shall be deemed to relieve Gulf Oil Corporation from liability to any person, firm or corporation due to damage occasioned by its salt water disposal operations.
