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Transcript of Hearing

Case No. 311

October 23, 1951



MR. SPURRIER: We will go on to Case 311.

(Mr. Kellahin reads the Notice of Publication.)

MR. HOLLIS: My name is W. T. Hollis with the El Paso Natural Gas Company. I would like to submit the testimony for this case.

(Witnesssworn.)

MR. HOLLIS: I have a letter here I would like to read which I believe will cover this case 311 as far as we are concerned.

"Please consider this letter as a petition for an unorthodox location covering the well and situation discussed below.

"Delhi Oil Corporation drilled their Florance-Federal No. 1-15 on our acreage due to a mistake by the surveyor. Delhi thought that they were drilling this well 990 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 5, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. However, it has been found that the well is actually located 486 feet from the North line and 323 feet from the West line of Section 4, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, San Juan County, New Mexico. El Paso Natural Gas Company purchased this well from Delhi and it has now become our responsibility to obtain approval from the Commission for this unorthodox location.
