TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. SPURRIER: Is there anyone to be heard in Case 330?

MR. TOWNSEND: Jim Townsend for Stanolind Oil and Gas Company.

At the time the case was called last month, or rather I should say a statement was made to the Commission last month that the case would be called this month and was requested by the San Juan operator or representative of the group that the case be continued. We understand that a petition has been filed by Pubco Development Corporation, a Company, that such case be continued and we have no objection to that. We think that probably it should be considered with the question of gas proration in the entire San Juan Basin, and Stanolind, while it is not urging the continuation, nor is it objecting to it, has no real concern about it being continued further at this time.

MR. SPURRIER: That is correct, Pubco did make a motion by letter for continuance. I don't have the letter at the moment. They did make a motion for continuance. As the Commission said at the last hearing, upon a proper motion we would continue the case to May 19th. Is there objection to Pubco's motion? If not the case will be continued to the regular May 19th hearing.
