Gentlemen:

The Ohio Oil Company respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico place on the docket of its regular March 20, 1952 hearings this application of Ohio for authorization to dually complete its Lou Wortham, Well No. 12, now drilling in the SE/4, NE/4, Section 11, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, in the Drinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Ohio plans to complete this well as an oil well in the Drinkard pay. Ohio is also desirous of completing this well dually in the Blinebry gas pay in such a manner as to produce Blinebry gas through the annulus between the tubing and casing and Drinkard oil through the tubing.

Ohio intends to install such efficient packer in this well and perform completion on this well in such a manner as will prevent waste in either reservoir.

At the time hearing is called on this application, Ohio will present data showing the completion program on this well and plans for future tests to be made regularly to determine that waste is not occurring in either reservoir.
