Dear Sir:

This will confirm your recent conversation with W. H. Mills, May 22, 1952, regarding the proposed removal of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's limiting gas-oil ratio of 2000 cubic feet per barrel in so far as producing wells in the Maljamar Paddock Pool are concerned.

We are cognizant of the nature of the producing reservoir, realizing that with such a thin productive section and relatively low permeability, producing gas-oil ratios will of necessity be comparatively excessive when considering the amount of oil produced.

With this in mind, Kewanee Oil Company interposes no objection to your request to remove the limiting gas-oil ratio from the field rules adopted for the Maljamar Paddock Pool by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.
