Dear Sir:

Because of the question raised in Case #617 and Case #618 as to the location of Texas Pacific Coal and Oil Company's N. M. State "A" a/c-1 Well #5, I have personally made a trip into the field to check the location. I have found that this plugged and abandoned well is in the E/2 NE/4 (1320' from the North line and 660' from the East line) of Section 20, Township 23 South, Range 36 East as stated in the Notice of Intention to Drill. There is no evidence of a well being drilled in either the SW/4 NE/4 or the SW/4 of Section 20; in fact, Well #5 is the only well ever drilled in that section. Consequently, it is requested that Well Record Form SG 108 dated 8/16/30 and Miscellaneous Report on Wells dated 10/13/30 and 10/25/30 be amended to read the E/2 NE/4 Sec. 20, T 23 S, R 36 E, instead of the indicated SW/4.
