ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a. m. on October 14, 1954, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this ¹⁷ day of November, 1954, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the Hogback-Pennsylvanian Pool, previously designated as a gas pool, should be redesignated as an oil pool, this action having been properly readvertised.
- (3) That extensions should be approved as advertised for the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, and the East Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as advertised.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico be, and the same hereby is, approved as follows:

- (a) That the Hogback-Pennsylvanian Pool, previously designated as a gas pool, should be reclassified as an oil pool for production of oil from the Pennsylvanian formation, retaining the designation Hogback-Pennsylvanian Pool, and described as:

TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 16 WEST, NMPM
All of Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9

(b) That the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool boundary as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 10 WEST, NMPM
S/2 Section 33

(c) That the East Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool boundary as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, NMPM
All of Section 20
