(a) Extension of the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool to include: TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, All of Sections 3 through 10; all of Sections 15, 16, 21, 22, 27, 28, 33 and 34

TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 5 WEST, All of Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12

TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, All of Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34

TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, All of Sections 1, 2 and 3; E/2 of Section 4

TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, All of sections 10 through 15; all of Sections 22 through 27; all of sections 34 through 36

TOWNSHIP 32 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, Sections 16 and 21, all

(b) Extension of the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool to include: TOWNSHIP 28 NORTH, RANGE 11 WEST, S/2 Section 29; S/2 Section 30/ N/2 Section 31, N/2 Section 32

A Yes. I recommend that the extension be made as advertised. These extensions are based upon the completion of the following three wells: Western Natural Gas Krause No. 1, southwest of Section 29, 28 north, 11 west, initial potential of 145 MCF per day.

Benton Montin Gallegos Canyon Unit No. 68 in the northeast of Section 14, 28 north, 12 west, with an initial potential of 113 MCF per day.

Southern Union Gas Robinson No. 1 in the northwest of Section 22, 29 north, 13 west, with an initial potential of 108 MCF per day.

Q Do you have anything further, Mr. Arnold?

A No, sir, I believe that covers it. I would like to offer this description.

MR. KITTS: Will you mark that Exhibit 1.
