Gentlemen:

It is respectfully requested that a hearing be set on the application of Stanolind Oil and Gas Company for an exception to Section (a) of Rule 309 of the Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to permit the production of more than eight (8) wells into common storage on the Stanolind operated South Mattix Unit, Fowler Field, Lea County, New Mexico.

There are at present ten producing oil wells on the South Mattix Unit property which comprises the following acreage in T-24-S, R-37-E:

Section 15:	All
Section 22:	NE/4, E/2 NW/4, N/2 SE/4, SE/4 SE/4

All of the interest in the above described acreage has been unitized and the interest are now common throughout. The unitized properties are operated by the Stanolind Oil and Gas Company.

Authority will be sought at the hearing to produce ten (10) wells, Nos. 1 through 10, into common storage. A hearing before the full Commission at the next regular monthly Statewide proration hearing will be satisfactory. A list of all offset operators is attached.
