

Pool CAPROCK-QUEEN

A 6x6 grid with numbers 1 through 36. The numbers are arranged in a boustrophedon pattern: Row 1 (left to right): 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1; Row 2 (right to left): 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12; Row 3 (left to right): 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18; Row 4 (right to left): 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24; Row 5 (left to right): 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30; Row 6 (right to left): 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36. A small green rectangle is drawn around cell 20.
