CASE 1114: Application of Continental Oil Company for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool in exception to Rule 5 (a) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool as set forth in Order R-520. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order authorizing a 240 acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool composed of the NW/4 and E/2 SW/4 of Section 31, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico; said unit to be dedicated to applicant's Lockhart "B-31" No. 6 Well located 1980 feet from the North and West lines of said Section 31.

CASE 1115: Application of Continental Oil Company for an order approving a dual completion in the Terry Blinbry Oil Pool and the Tubb Gas Pool under Rule 112 (a) of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Statewide Rules and Regulations. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order granting permission to dually complete, by the use of a cross-over assembly whereby the Tubb gas zone will be produced at the surface through the casing-tubing annulus and the Terry Blinbry oil zone will be produced at the surface through the tubing, their Lockhart "B-11" Well Number 14 located 1980 feet from the South and East lines of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.
