A P P L I C A T I O N

Comes now applicant, Continental Oil Company, and respectfully petitions the Commission for an order pooling the working interests in the NE/4 and E/2 NW/4 of Section 28-T 20S-R 37E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Eumont pool and in support thereof would show:

1. That applicant is the co-owner and is the operator for the WMFU of the NE/4 NE/4, SW/4 NE/4 and E/2 NW/4 of said Section 28.

2. That the NW/4 NE/4 of said Section 28 is under lease by assignment to the following:

A & M Oil Company	25%
Norris Antweil	25%

3. That the working interest ownership of the SE/4 NE/4 of said Section 28 is as follows:

4. That all owners of working interests in the tracts named hereinabove have executed an agreement of communitization covering the above mentioned tracts with the exception of Della Turland and Doll Turland.

5. That said Della Turland and Doll Turland have refused to execute the said agreement for communitization.

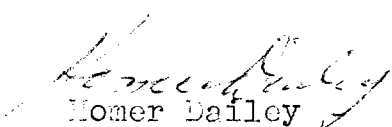
6. That applicant is drilling a well to which the tracts mentioned above are to be allocated for gas proration purposes.

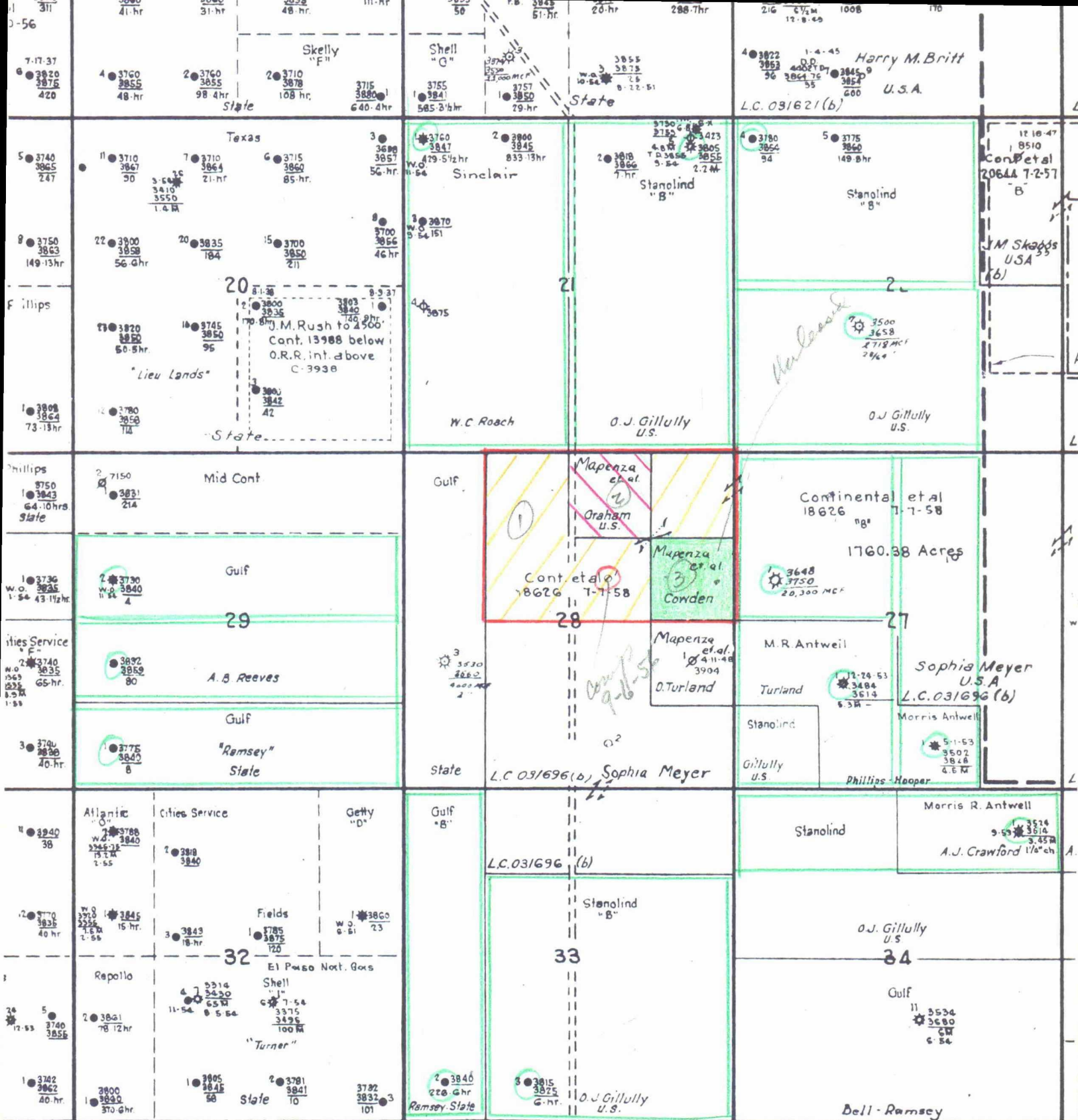
7. That approval of the Commission by Administrative Order MSP-295 for a non-standard gas proration unit for the lands covered by the communitization agreement, to wit, NE/4 and E/2 NW/4 of said Section 28, has been given contingent upon the filing of an affidavit of communitization, and that such affidavit cannot be furnished because of the refusal of the said Della Turland and Doll Turland to sign said agreement.

8. That unless a forced pooling order is entered in this matter the working interest owners in said lands will be deprived of the opportunity to recover their fair share of the gas under their leases.

Wherefore applicant prays that this matter be set for hearing upon due notice and that upon hearing an order be entered pooling the working interests under the NE/4 and E/2 NW/4 Section 28-T 20S-R 37N, Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Lumont pool.
