TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. PORTER: The next case on the docket will be 1217.

MR. COOLEY: Case 1217. Application of Pan American Pet-
roleum Corporation for permission to convert its State "A" Tract 9
Well No. 13, Hobbs Pool, into a salt water disposal well in accord-
ance with Rule 701 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

MR. SMITH: J. K. Smith; Pan American Petroleum Corporation
would like to move for dismissal of the case. Mr. Kelly has al-
ready stated the reasons, and I consider it unnecessary to go into

the reasons again at this time. However, I would like to advise the Commission that we plan to select another well, or drill another well in the near future so that we will be proceeding with our plan for the disposal of salt water as quickly as possible. I might even say also that the next case, if you want to take it up at this time, we would like to dismiss it too.

MR. PORTER: Any objections to counsel's proposal to dismiss Cases 1217 and 1218? These cases will be dismissed.

MR. NUTTER: Let the record show that the reasons for the dismissal will appear in Case 1053, please.

MR. SMITH: I didn't quite understand the representative from Sun Oil Company's remarks about the transfer of allowable. Inasmuch as the cases are now moot, I guess we can leave to a future date whether transfer of allowable is equitable. We think it is or we wouldn't have made request for it at that time.

MR. PORTER: We will have to take that up at an appropriate time.
