(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.


(2) That the applicant, Pan American Petroleum Corporation, made an appearance by its attorney and requested that this case be dismissed.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:
