MR. PORTER: We have a few minutes before we will recess for lunch. We have picked out a couple of short cases that we can probably dispose of before that time. We will take up the next case, 1279.

MR. COOLEY: In the matter of the hearing called by the Oil Conservation Commission upon its own motion to permit Roy T. Short, M. N. Hamilton, Apache Basin Oil Company, and Basin Oil Company, and all other interested parties to appear and show cause

why the hole located 660 feet from the South and West lines of Section 25, Township 16 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico, should not be ordered plugged and abandoned in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico.

At this time I would like to move that Case 1279 be continued indefinitely due to the recent developments, and we have been unable to reach Mr. Short. After repeated attempts, he informs us that it may be possible to contact Mr. Hamilton, who, as Mr. Short says Mr. Hamilton is responsible for the <sup>drilling</sup> ~~building~~ of the hole. We would like to make further investigation and at the time the case is placed on the docket again, I would recommend to the Commission that the case be readvertised.

MR. PORTER: Is there objection to counsel's motion for an indefinite continuation for Case 1279? Case will be indefinitely continued.

Commission of New Mexico, a quorum being present,


FINDS:
