MAINTENANCE, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING
THE TRANSFER OF ALLOWABLES FOR THE
INJECTION WELL TO OTHER WELLS ON THE
SAME BASIC LEASE, AND FURTHER, TO
EXEMPT CERTAIN OF HIS WELLS FROM GAS-OIL
RATIO PENALTIES.

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


That the application of John H. Trigg in Case No. 1292 be and the same is hereby dismissed.
