APPLICATION

COMES NOW, Malco Refineries, Inc., a New Mexico corporation, respectfully presents this application for approval of an unorthodox oil well location, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. Applicant is the owner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and on or about June 21, 1957, the Applicant had said land surveyed for the purpose of staking a location for the drilling of the William-Stirling #4 Well. The location was subsequently surveyed and a plat thereof was filed with this Commission and attached hereto as Exhibit "A". The plat showed the proposed location for the William-Stirling #4 Well to be at a point 2,310 feet from the North line and 1,650 feet from the West line of Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

2. Applicant spudded the well at the exact location of the stake; drilled the well to the total depth of 1,776 feet, and completed the well, on or about July 8, 1957, as a producer of oil.

3. After the drilling and completion of the well at the original staked location, information came to the attention of the Applicant that the well was possibly erroneously located; therefore, Applicant caused a new survey to be made on September 25, 1957 and

it was determined by this new survey, a copy of which is hereto attached as Exhibit "B", that the actual location of the well was at a point 2,540 feet from the North line and 1,650 feet from the West line of Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. Upon completion of this survey on September 26, 1957, Applicant notified the Commission of the unorthodox location as described above.

4. The unorthodox location was not the fault of the Applicant and the Applicant will suffer undue hardships if the subject application is not approved.

5. The ownership of the off set locations, being the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, which may be affected by the unorthodox location is shown on the attached Exhibit "C", and the addresses of such owners are also set out.

6. The addresses of the surveyors who prepared Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" are respectively as follows:

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set down for hearing before the Commission, or Examiner, at the earliest possible time; notice of said hearing be given as required by law; and that upon the evidence introduced at the hearing, this Commission enter its order in this case approving the unorthodox location of the Malco Refineries, Inc., William-Stirling #4 Well, at a point 2,540 feet from the North line and 1,650 feet from the West line of Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., in the Red Lake Pool, in Eddy County, New Mexico, and that said well be granted the same allowable that it would receive if said well were in an orthodox location.






