
Western Natural Gas Company respectfully requests a hearing to consider this application for permission to dually complete its Wimberley well #4 in such a manner that the Fusselman and Drinkard reservoirs may be produced through parallel strings of tubing and in support thereof states as follows:

1. Western Natural Gas Company's Wimberley #4 will be located 1980' from the North line and 990' from West line of Section 24, 25-S, 37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. The well will have 13 3/8" surface casing, 9 5/8" intermediate casing, and 7" production casing set per the attached completion plat.
3. We propose to perforate the 7" casing opposite the Drinkard zone from 5925' to 5965'. This zone was found to be productive on drill stem test in Western's Wimberley #3 located 1320' north.
4. We propose to perforate the 7" opposite the Fusselman zone from 7000' to 7050'. This zone was found productive during completion tests on Western's Wimberley #3. The two zones will be separated within the well bore by a production packer set at 6975'.

5. We are attaching a plat showing the acreage to be dedicated to the well, well location, and offset operators.
6. Also attached is a diagrammatic sketch showing the proposed mechanical completion of the well.
7. It is the opinion of the applicant that the manner and method proposed for the dual completion of this well is mechanically feasible and practical, and is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.
8. The applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two zones.
9. By copy of this letter, all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.






