
Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company respectfully requests an Examiners Hearing to be scheduled for the purpose of securing approval of a non-standard gas proration unit as a result of the completion of El Paso Natural Gas Company's Howell #2-G Well located 990' from the South line and 990' from the West line, Section 6, Township 30 North, Range 8 West, as a gas well from the Mesaverde Formation on November 30, 1957.

The drilling unit dedicated to the Howell #2-G Well consists of the W/2 or (Lots 3,4,5,6,7, SE/4 NW/4, E/2 SW/4) of Section 6 and the NW/4 or (Lots 1,2, E/2 NW/4) of Section 7, Township 30 North, Range 8 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

An Examiners Hearing is requested in order to secure approval of the proposed non-standard proration unit due to the fact that the drilling unit containing 331.00 acres lies within two government sections and therefore is not subject to administrative approval under Order No. R-128-C as requested by our application dated March 4, 1958 and executed March 18, 1958.
